Develop new environmental skills for new markets

Finding out who is running training courses and deciding exactly what your business needs are can be hard work. Through the Enviroskills service, training providers across the South East are offering accredited short, practical business courses on environmental skills that are aimed at supervisory to senior management or professional level people.

Take advantage of these developing market areas to develop your skills and sales.

Subsidised places are available on all of the courses listed below.

Create your own Environmental Management System (1 day course)

This ASET Certificate Level 3 Award course will cover topics such as the EMS-14001 programme, Environmental targets, Environmental Law and understanding how BS 8555 and ISO 14004 can improve your business efficiency. Normal cost £90. Subsidised Enviroskills cost **£40** per participant.

Environmental Awareness for Business (1 day course)

This Level 3 course accredited by IEMA will provide an introduction to understanding how the earth works, definitions of sustainable development, current environmental issues and their relevance to your organisation. Normal cost £200. Subsidised Enviroskills cost **£125** per participant.

Waste Awareness for Business (1 day course)

This Level 3 course accredited by CIWM provides the knowledge, understanding and skills to enable best practice in management and reduction of your business waste. Learn how your business can reduce costs, stay legal and be sustainable.

Normal cost £180. Subsidised Enviroskills cost **£120** per participant.

Generating Energy from Waste (1 day course)

This Level 3 course accredited by The Open College Network will give attendees the knowledge to evaluate information on waste to power technologies, assess their onsite resource, analyse likely costs and savings, and enable them to make investment and management decisions. This course is aimed at farmers, land owners or managers, rural business and organisations that process or handle biodegradable waste, control a natural resource such as cropland/woodland, manure, organic matter or crop waste.

Normal cost £75. Subsidised Enviroskills cost **£25** per participant.

Energy from Biomass (1 day course)

This Level 3 course accredited by The Open College Network will equip the business manager with the skills to assess the characteristics of their own business, the relative benefits of different systems and the major obstacles that will need to be considered. This course is aimed at farmers, land owners or managers, rural business and organisations with biomass resource, the potential to cultivate biomass, or potential to process local biomass.

Normal cost £75. Subsidised Enviroskills cost **£25** per participant.

Organics Waste Recycling (1 day course)

This Level 3 course accredited by CIWM gives an introduction to composting and the benefits of using compost in a variety of applications. The course will also cover marketing and compost end users, planning and licensing of composting sites and quality standards to produce compost. It will include a visit to a best practice composting site to show how compost is produced commercially,
Normal cost £65. Subsidised Enviroskills cost **£15** per participant.
